The organising committee invites participants to actively contribute to the scientific programme of the meeting. All accepted abstracts of oral and poster presentations will be published in "Der Pathologe".

Please submit your abstract to monika.walz@kssg.ch as an attached document (deadline for abstract submission: **September 9, 2012**). The submitting author will be notified about acceptance of the abstract.

Detailed instructions for abstract submission:

- 1. Please use the abstract submission form available at www.pathologie.kssq.ch
- 2. Structure the abstract as follows: Background, Methods, Results and Conclusions
- 3. The length of the abstract should not exceed 250 words (excluding title and affiliations)
- 4. The title should appear in capital letters
- 5. For each author provide last name followed by first and middle initials (Muster F. Holzer G)
- 6. List affiliation of each author
- 7. Full address with phone and fax numbers and e-mail address of the first author (= corresponding author) must be provided

 The first author will receive all subsequent communications concerning the abstract by e-mail only
- 8. Select your preferred type of presentation (oral or poster presentation)
- 9. It is the responsibility of the submitting author to ascertain that all authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission.

Oral presentations

Only Powerpoint presentations are possible. Authors are requested to deliver their presentations at least one hour before the beginning of the session.

Posters

Posters will be displayed at the ground floor of the Institute of Pathology. Poster size should not exceed 1.40m (height) by 0,90m (width). Authors are requested to display posters on Thursday, November 8, 2012 at 13:00 and to remove it by Friday November 9, 2012 after the last presentation. Authors are asked to be available for questions and discussion at their posters during the poster sessions.

The most interesting posters will be selected for a brief oral presentation (3 minutes) in the lecture hall (Scientific Session VI). Therefore, all first authors of posters should also prepare up to 3 Powerpoint slides summarising their work.

Poster Prizes

A jury will select the best poster in three categories: basic research, clinical research and case report. The awards will be presented at the Gala Dinner.

Workshop

The workshop on lymphoma pathology is reserved to residents and young staff pathologists. Workshop participation requires registration for the meeting. Participation is covered by registration fee of the meeting.


